Let's go for a walk/hike on the Sunday after the Reunion Party!



I've picked a fairly easy walk that is partly on the paved Nimitz Way leading north from Inspiration Point and partly on the trails that lead up through the Rotarian Peace Grove to Wildcat Peak. The terrain generally rolls up and down, with some (not too much) sustained climbing as we mount the peak.

Wildcat Peak affords great views in all directions, back and south to Mt. Diablo, west to San Francisco and the Bay, and north to Suisun Bay.
